



Probing the Depths: First SWERVE funded voyage maps risks of Baltic seabed mining

As demand for critical minerals grows, understanding the environmental risks of seabed mining is urgent. On the first SWERVE expedition, Francisco Nascimento's team collected baseline data aboard KBV 181 to close knowledge gaps and improve ecological risk assessments.

Tracking Change Beneath the Waves: A Baltic Sea Research Cruise

What happens to the seafloor when trawling stops? The recent SWERVE funded research cruise set out to find out. Focusing on changes in the southern Baltic Sea since the 2019 trawling ban. By repeating earlier surveys, Clare Bradshaw's team gathered data to track ecosystem recovery.


